

Navigating around Frog

Welcome to Frog Courses. Your platform designed to deliver training to your entire organisation. Each employee can work through the training at their own pace and you can easily monitor their progress.

Frog has a number of interactive elements, because training needs to be engaging. Over the course of this module, you see how to administrate the platform, tailor it to your vision. You'll see how to create modules and resources, then publish them.

Frog can be thought of like an operating system. This bar at the top of the screen is the FrogBar. Like the Windows taskbar, from here you can search for content on the platform, create new content and access the system menus

Frog is made up of applications, sites and widgets. Within Quick Launch are applications you have access to. Applications are how you manage Frog, from the Users app and Groups and Policies to the Reporting tools.

Clicking off Quick Launch and returning to the Dashboard. This is a site in Frog. A mini-website where you can add content.

If I now click this Edit button, the editing panel opens from the site.

And in here, are the widgets. The individual tools can be dragged into any of the dotted, layout boxes, which you can use to add content. This can be text, images, videos, files and even interactive content such as questions, forums or SCORM files.

We'll get into Site building later in this module. For now, I'll close the editor and return to the Quick Launch menu.

From here, I will open FrogDrive.

FrogDrive gives you access to all modules and sites on the platform. You have a personal drive for files and shared drives you can use to store resources.

Quizzes and SCORM files are found here too, as well as Form and Poll templates.

Finally for this video, I going to click on the Profile menu. Your initials will appear here. As Admins, you can a quick link to your documents area in FrogDrive. And you also have System Preferences. You will use this application to set global controls for your Frog.

It is from the Profile menu, where you will log out of Frog too.
